ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
 - at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence. (Section 19, Licensing Act 2003)
- 3. Where this licence authorises the exhibition of films the admission of children must be restricted in accordance with the British Board of Film Classification.
- 4. Where this licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, these individuals must be licensed by the Security Authority (Section 21, Licensing Act 2003).

ANNEX 2 - LICENSING OBJECTIVES
