**ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS**

1. *No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:*

- *at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or*
- *at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.*

2. *Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence. (Section 19, Licensing Act 2003)*

3. *Where this licence authorises the exhibition of films the admission of children must be restricted in accordance with the British Board of Film Classification.*

4. *Where this licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, these individuals must be licensed by the Security Authority (Section 21, Licensing Act 2003).*

**ANNEX 2 - LICENSING OBJECTIVES**
